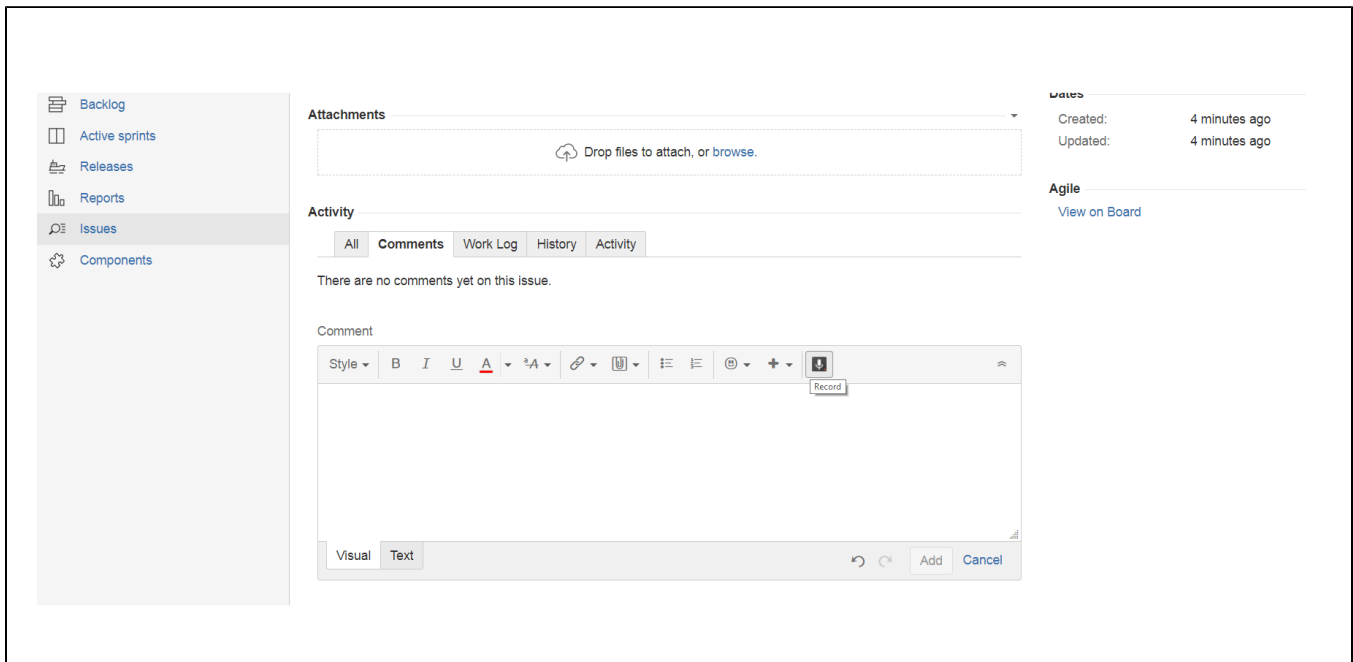


Voice Recorder for Jira

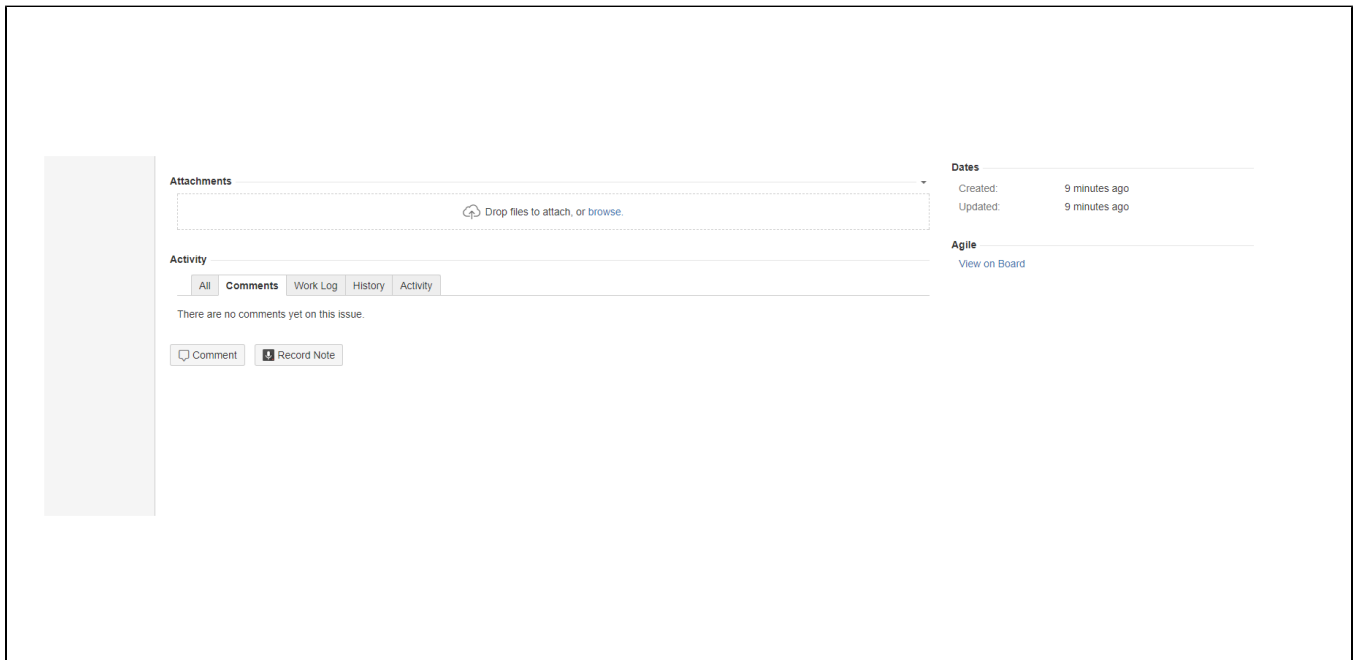
Simply improve and accelerate the collaboration with you team using Voice Recorder for Jira.
