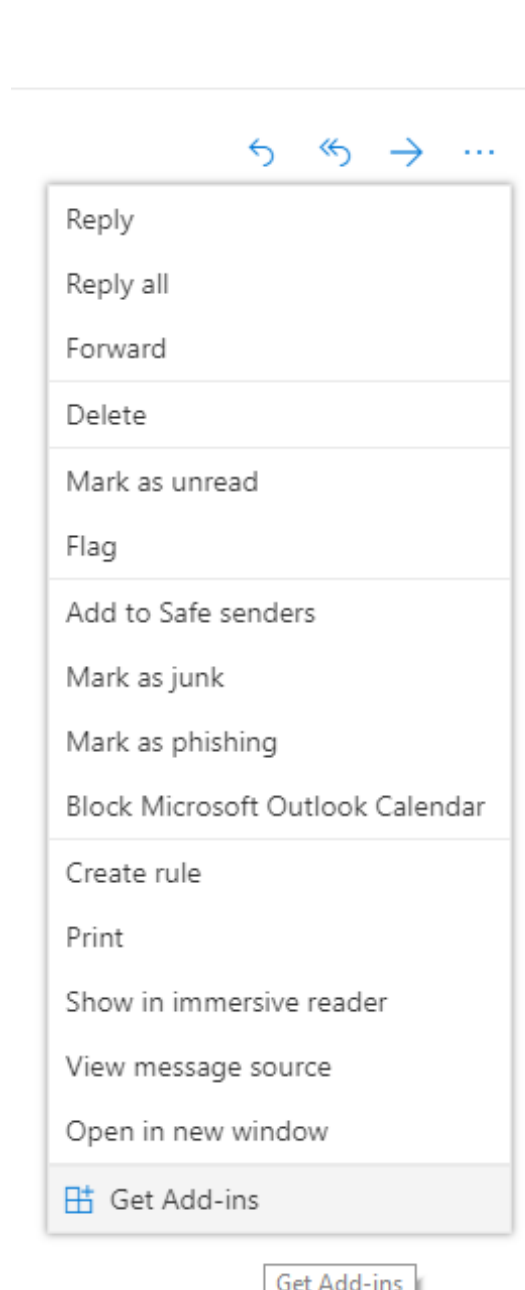


How to add OTJ Office add-in from URL
